To whom it may concern,

YASKAWA is pleased to answer your inquiry about the REACH regulation EC 1907/2006 as follows.

As per our commitment under article 33 of the said regulation, we declare, to the best of our knowledge and as of the date of publication of this information, regarding the presence of SVHC in YASKAWA products:

YASKAWA does not manufacture or import products with intended release of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as listed in the so-called candidate list. We and our suppliers are monitoring this, and we will inform you in case of presence of substances in our products more than the limit allowed on the REACH candidate list.

The candidate list was updated 14. June 2023 and contains 235 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC).


In accordance with regulation (EU) 2018/851 YASKAWA will notify the SCIP data base (Substances of Concern In articles as such or in complex objects (Products)) managed by ECHA on products containing candidate list substances. Our customers will be informed about related applicable notification numbers.
